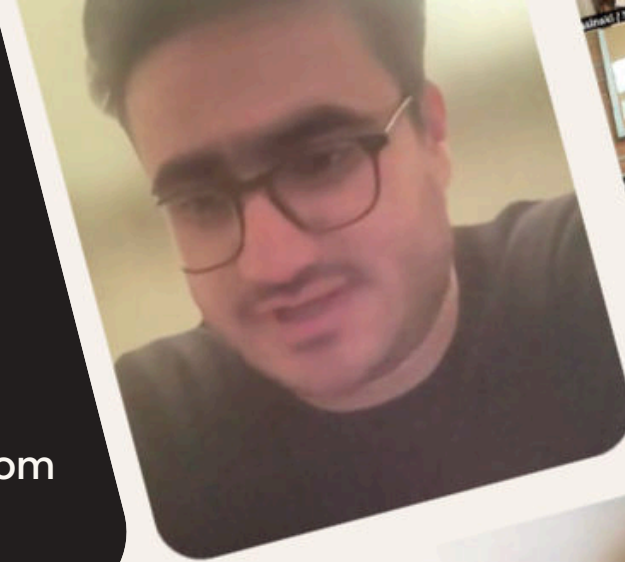

What is News Decoder?

News Decoder informs, connects and empowers young people to become active global citizens by learning the tools and techniques of journalism. We envision a world where every young person, regardless of where they live or what school they attend, has the skills to navigate complexity, question sources, appreciate diverse perspectives and communicate with clarity and purpose.

What partnership means

The News Decoder team collaborates with you to design learning experiences that fit your students' needs, your teachers' goals and your school's values. We help you evolve and adapt to the core challenges in education today.

What are the benefits of partnership?

- **Curriculum Integration Support:** We'll work with your faculty to integrate journalism and media literacy into existing courses.
- **Student Journalism Mentorship:** Your students receive one-on-one editing and guidance as they pitch, report, draft and publish their stories.
- **Custom Workshops:** We design and deliver workshops tailored to your needs, from writing to interviewing techniques to week-long journalism intensives.
- **Professional Development:** We offer training workshops for faculty on teaching project-based learning, "teacher as student" experiences, integrating AI into curriculum design and facilitating cross-border exchanges.
- **Access to Correspondent Network:** Invite our correspondents to speak with your students via video call. They've reported from conflict zones, covered UN climate summits, interviewed world leaders.
- **Decoder Dialogues:** Bring your whole school to our public webinars, or we can organize private Dialogues on topics you're studying.
- **Full Platform Access:** All your students get access to News Decoder Academy courses, the Changemakers' Toolkit and our archive of 1,500+ news stories.

PARTNERSHIP LEVELS

Flexible options for different needs. Schools pay a fee for a level that best suits their needs. We offer programs with a range of benefits, from occasional workshops to full year-long integration.

YEAR-LONG SCHOOL MEMBERSHIP

Full access for your entire school community, with systematic engagement throughout the academic year. Includes virtual orientation workshops, ongoing editorial mentorship and integration into both classroom instruction and extracurricular activities. *Best for:* Schools ready to make innovative youth civic engagement a sustained part of their program.

CLASSROOM-LEVEL PROGRAMS

Embed journalism and civic engagement training into a single course through 2- to 4-week experiences with live workshops and asynchronous editor collaboration. *Best for:* Individual teachers who want to pilot News Decoder with a class project before expanding.

NEWS DECODER CAMPS

Intensive one-week experiences where young people step out of the classroom, learn journalism techniques and work with editors to develop and publish stories. *Best for:* Schools that want a concentrated, high-impact experience during a specific week (great for interim terms or special programs).

NEWS DECODER CLUBS

Support for student-led clubs where young people control their agenda while developing leadership and accountability. *Best for:* Schools with a student newspaper, government or extracurricular culture. Requires a faculty sponsor.

NEWS DECODER WORKSHOPS

Limited or one-time workshops to introduce journalistic storytelling concepts, from finding a story to how to make a podcast. *Best for:* Schools looking to kick-start a program with a focused goal.
